

Olive Oil & Sustainability: a future forward

Students offered scholarships in olive oil research

Istituto Nutrizionale Carapelli Foundation is pleased to announce the availability of four scholarships, each worth 6,000 euros, to graduate or undergraduate university students in developing countries who are involved in research on olive oil.

The Istituto Nutrizionale Carapelli is a non-profit organisation that promotes the research in olive oil science, including chemistry, technology, history, quality and nutrition aspects.

Two scholarships will be granted to two outstanding projects aimed at enhancing sustainability in the production of olive oil. The other two will be assigned to projects specifically focused on human health.

Students residing in Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, Libya, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, and Iraq are eligible to apply, with an eye to their requiring the Foundation's assistance in discovering qualitative and quantitative improvements in olive oil production.

Applicants should submit a curriculum vitae, a detailed three-page overview of their project, a declaration by their supervisor that the project can be undertaken within their facilities (and why it should), a letter of intent and the Privacy acceptance form signed. Application should be sent in English to istituto.nutrizionale@carapellifirenze.it by **October 31st 2022**.

Submissions will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee of the Istituto Nutrizionale Carapelli and selection will be done according to specific criteria that include originality, previous experience, technology readiness, and project's potential for providing novel data within a reasonable timeframe.

Recipients will be announced **on or before December 1st 2022**.
